

## Initial HHP7600 Terminal Connection Process

*NOTE: You should have attended a Verizon Training Session in the use of this data collection kit, and have received all necessary instructions directly from Verizon (including valid user name and password).*

- 1) Double tap the VTSync Client icon on the “desktop”
- 2) Enter your Verizon User name and Password (use the pop up keyboard)
- 3) Tap the keyboard icon in the tray at the bottom of the screen (near the right edge)
- 4) Tap on Hide Input Panel
- 5) Tap Dial-up Settings
- 6) Verify the phone number entered is 18664833201. If the number is correct then proceed to step 10. If a different number is shown proceed to step 7.
- 7) Highlight the phone number (drag your stylus across the existing number from right to left)
- 8) Press the **BKSP** key to erase the existing number
- 9) Using the **terminal keypad** (not onscreen, but “real keys”) type in the new number: 18664833201
- 10) Press the **Ent** key on the keypad to return to the Settings screen
- 11) Tap OK in the upper right corner of the display
- 12) Tap Connect once you are ready to proceed (make sure all physical connections are ready)
